

And the said parties of the first part further agree to keep the buildings adequately insured against loss or damage by fire,

And to secure the performance of their said covenants and obligations above set forth, and in consideration of the said premises,

The said parties of the first part do, by these presents, mortgage unto the party of the second part, the said Division of Home Missions and Church Extension of the Board of Missions and Church Extension of the Methodist Church, all of the following described property, to-wit:

A certain lot or piece of land, situate, lying and being in the District of Greenville and state aforesaid, bounded as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on Isaac Chandler's line, thence N 88 3/4 E 6 chains to a stake 3X joining to Owens & Vincent Jenkins, thence S 7 1/2 E 8 chains to a stake near road leading to McElbany ford, thence along the road to a red oak, on Isaac Chandler's line, thence along said Chandler's line N 8.80 chains to the place of beginning, containing and laid out for five and one-third acres of land (5 1/3) less 1.9 A. deeded to J.
