TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

EDWIN M. RAMMINGER (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of Four Thousand, Five Hundred and no/100 - - - - DOLLARS (\$ 4,500.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Butler Township, and being on the west side of Rocky Slope Road, just off of the Woodruff Road, being shown as a portion of Lot No. 9 on plat of property of E. R. Haynie, made by P. B. Wilson, Jr., Surveyor, October 1945, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book S, Page 163, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west side of Rocky Slope Road at the southeast corner of Lot 9, also corner of property of Robert L. Hughes and running thence with the Hughes line, S. 64-20 W. 208.71 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 24-45 W. 100 feet to an iron pin at corner of property of James L. Swindler and Ruth H. Swindler; thence along line of property of Swindlers in an easterly direction, 210 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the west side of Rocky Slope Road; thence along the west side of Rocky Slope Road, S. 26-45 E. 108 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described property is the same conveyed to the mortgagor herein by deed of E. R. Haynie of even date herewith and to be recorded.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
