To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

Whereas, I, H. D. QUINN, SENDS GREETING: the said H. D. Quinn hereinafter called the mortgagor(s) in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to Bug Norris hereinafter called the mortgagee(s), in the full and just sum of SIX THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED AND NO/100

-----DOLLARS (\$ 6,200.00), to be paid as follows: The sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars to be paid on the principal on the 28th day of November, 1952 and the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars on the 28th day of February, May, August and November of each year thereafter, up to and including the 28th day of May, 1955, and the balance of the principal then remaining to be paid on the 28th day of August, 1955.

with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) percentum per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly in advance

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if, before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor(s) promise to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness at attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said mortgagor(s), in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said mortgagee(s) according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said mortgagor(s), in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee(s) at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bug Norris, her heirs and assigns, forever.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate in Greenville Township, in the County of Greenville, S. C., and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the east side of Buncombe Road, corner of the F.W. Poe Mfg. Co. property and running thence N. 56 E. 54 feet to a stake in right of way of the (old) G & L. R. R.; thence N. 82 E. 173 feet to a stake; thence S. 23-3/4 E., 22 1/2 feet to a stake in center of line of Lot No. 10 of Mountain City Land and Improvement Co.; thence S. 74 W. 166 feet to an angle; thence S. 59 W. 54 feet, more or less, to a stake on Buncombe Road, center of line on said Lot No. 10; thence along said Buncombe Road in a northerly direction, 40 feet to the beginning, as shown by a survey and plat made by W. A. Hester on the 23rd day of November, 1927.

An interest in this property was conveyed to the mortgagor by deed of Mrs. Lula Quinn, et al, dated January 29, 1951, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.
