TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

We, Dorothy Blair and Wyoma Blair
(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto W. T. Putman

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Nine Hundred and No/100- - -

DOLLARS (\$ 900.00),

with interest thereon from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: \$25.00 on October 6, 1952, and a like payment of \$25.00 on the 6th day of each successive month thereafter until paid in full; said payments to be applied first to interest and then to principal, with interest thereon from date at the rate of 6% per annum, to be computed and paid monthly.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, his heirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the Northeast side of Hawthorne Lane, in the City of Greenville, being shown as lot No. 91 on plat of Langley Heights, made by Dalton & Neves in June 1937, recorded in Plat Book N at Page 133, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the Northeast side of Hawthorne Lane, at corner of lot 90, and running thence with line of said lot, N. 46-05 E. 350.6 feet, more or less, to a stake on Brushy Creek; thence with the Creek as the line, N. 33-15 W. 60 feet to a stake at corner of lot 92; thence with the line of said lot, S. 44-19 W. 360.3 feet to a stake on Hawthorne Lane; thence with the Northeast side of Hawthorne Lane, S. 44-37 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner."

Being the same premises conveyed to the mortgagors by W. T. Putman by deed to be recorded herewith.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
