MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, A. K. Edens and Mae O. Edens, of Greenville County, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said A. K. Edens and Mae O. Edens

in and by our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of One Thousand, Eight Hundred, Fifty and No/100 - (\$ 1,850.00 )

Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of Eighteen and 50/100 - - - - - (\$ 18.50 ) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said A. K. Edens and Mae O. Edens

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to us,

the said A. K. Edens and Mae O. Edens

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the northeast side of Seventh Avenue, near the City of Greenville, shown as Lot 252, Section 1, on plat entitled "Sub-division of Village Houses, F. W. Poe Manufacturing Company, Greenville, S. C.", made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, July 1950, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "Y", at pages 26-31 inclusive, said lot fronting 70.3 feet along the northeast side of Seventh Avenue, running back to a depth of 75 feet along the southeast side to a depth of 75 feet on the northwest side and being 75 feet across the rear; being the same conveyed to us by Roy J. Fuller and Blanche B. Fuller by deed dated February 8, 1952 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 450, at page 454.

"This mortgage also covers the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty."
