WE, HENRY W. GOLDSBERRY AND VERA M. GOLDSBERRY, SEND GREETING:

Whereas, we, the said Henry W. Goldsberry and Vera M. Goldsberry,
 in and by our certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these
 Presents, are well and truly indebted to Central Development Corporation

in the full and just sum of Seven Hundred Seventy-six and no/100 (\$776.00)

Dollars, to be paid as follows: \$20.00 on the first day of
 November, 1952, and \$20.00 on the first day of each month thereafter
 until paid in full with the privilege of anticipating any or all pay-
 ments, said payments to be applied first to interest and then to prin-
 cipal.

with interest thereon from October 4, 1952,
 at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly

until paid in full: all interest not paid when due to bear
 interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid,
 the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who
 may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the
 hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof
 necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage
 in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises
 to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to
 the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

 sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

CENTRAL DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION, Its Successors and Assigns:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township,
 Greenville County, State of South Carolina, within the corporate limits
 of the City of Greenville, and being known and designated as Lot Number
 138 of the Property of Central Development Corporation according to a
 plat of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat
 Book BB at Pages 22-23, and having the following metes and bounds, to
 wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Eastern side of Dellwood Drive at the joint
 front corner of Lots 137 and 138 and running thence with the joint line
 of Lots 137 and 138 S 60-10 E approximately 175 feet to a point in a
 Branch, the joint rear corner of Lots 137 and 138; thence with said
 Branch as a line approximately S 20-06 W approximately 87.4 feet to a
 point, the joint rear corner of Lots 138 and 139; thence with the joint
 line of Lots 138 and 139 N 59-47 W approximately 182.4 feet to a point
 on the Eastern side of Dellwood Drive at the joint front corner of Lots
