are well and truly indebted to

Dollars, in and by our certain promissory note in writing of even date herewith, due and payable --
Six (6) months from date hereof,

with interest from date at the rate of five (5%) per centum per annum
until paid; interest to be computed and paid semi-annually and if unpaid when due to
bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and we have further promised and agreed to pay ten per
cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceed-
ings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we , the said Edward J. Jaskwhich and Dorothy C. Jaskwhich
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money
aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in
consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said --

South Carolina National Bank, Greenville, South Carolina, its successors and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being
near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of
South Carolina, being known and designated as property of E. J.
Jaskwhich, plat of which was made by Dalton & Neves, Surveyors,
January, 1951, and having, according to said plat, the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of a 40-foot road, common
corner with property now or formerly owned by L. L. Richbourg and
running thence through the center of said 40-foot road N. 42.58 W.
932.7 feet to a point; thence S. 70-25W. 375 feet, more or less,
to a point in the line of the property of A. L. Beam, which point
is 275 feet in a Southeasterly direction from the corner of the
property of A. L. Beam and E. J. Jaskwhich and running thence S.
25-40 E. 307.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 39-14W. 520 feet
to an iron pin; thence S. 40-46E. 539 feet to an iron pin on a
creek; thence along the creek with courses and distances as follows:
N. 14-50E. 450 feet, N. 59-0E 148.5 feet, N. 84-0E. 665 feet, more
