To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

CAROLINE B. MOSELEY
Whereas, I, the said Caroline B. Moseley SEND GREETING:
hereinafter called the mortgagor(s)
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, as well and truly
indebted to The South Carolina National Bank of Charleston
hereinafter called the mortgagee(s), in the full and just sum of Four Thousand Five Hundred
and No/100 - - - - - DOLLARS (\$ 4500.00), to be paid
one year from date,

, with interest thereon from date
at the rate of Five (5%) percentum per annum, to be computed and paid
quarterly until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear
interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole
amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose
this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if, be-
fore its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder
should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases
the mortgagor(s) promise to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be
added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said mortgagee(s) according to the terms of the said note, and also in con-
sideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said mortgagor(s), in hand well and truly paid by the said mort-
gagee(s) at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said The South Carolina National
Bank of Charleston, its successors and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land with the improvements thereon situate, lying and
being on the Northeast side of Crestline Road near the City of Green-
ville, in Greenville County, S. C., shown as Lot 17, Block A, on plat of
Hilandale Heights made by T. M. Welborn, Surveyor, October 7, 1950, re-
corded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book
Y, at page 113, said lot fronting 99 feet along the Northeast side of
Crestline Road and running back to a depth of 200 feet on the Southeast
side, to a depth of 210.4 feet on the Northwest side, and being 145
feet across the rear.
