until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land with improvements thereon lying and being on the East side of Augusta Road about 10 miles South of the Greenville County Court House in Oaklawn Township, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina and containing one (1) acre according to a survey made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, April 18, 1945, and having, according to said survey, the following metes and bounds to wit:-

BEGINNING at a stake in the field on the East side of the Augusta Road and running thence N. 89 E. 270.1 feet to a stake; thence N. 1 W. 160.4 feet to a stake; thence S. 89 W. 270.1 feet to a stake; thence S. 1 E. 160.4 feet to the beginning point.

This being the same lot of land conveyed to me by G. T. Darby by deed dated April 8, 1946 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Vol. 299 at page 286.
