TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Margie H. Daniels (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

----- FIFTY-SEVEN HUNDRED & NO/100 -----
DOLLARS (\$ 5700.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of Five (5%) -----
per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the eastern side of Druid Street, in the City of Greenville, being shown and designated as Lots Nos. 19 and 20, Block D, as shown on plat of Stone Estates, recorded in Plat Book G at Page 292, and being more particularly described according to a recent survey of J. C. Hill, dated February 15, 1951, and

"Beginning at an iron pin on the eastern side of Druid Street, 150 feet southwest from the intersection of Druid and Reid Streets, and is the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 21, and running thence with Druid Street S. 11-22 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 18 and 19; thence with joint line of said lots S. 78-38 E. 160 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 11-22 E. 50 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 21; thence with joint line of said lots N. 78-38 W. 160 feet to the point of beginning; being the same premises conveyed to James D. Daniels by J. T. Collins, as Trustee, by deed recorded in Volume 432 at Page 189. The said James D. Daniels died testate October 16, 1953, and by his will filed in Apt. 622, File 12, devised the said property to the mortgagor herein."

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
