We, Margaret A. Coleman and Minnie Lou Coleman, SEND GREETING:  
WHEREAS, we the said Margaret A. Coleman and Minnie Lou Coleman,

in and by our certain promissory note in writing of even date with these presents are well and truly in-  
debted to The First National Bank of Greenville, S. C., as Trustee under  
Agreement with Bug Norris dated August 21, 1953,  
in the full and just sum of Fifteen Hundred and No/100ths  
(\$1,500.00) DOLLARS, to be paid ~~xx~~ in Greenville, S. C., together with  
interest thereon from date hereof until maturity at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum,  
said principal and interest being payable in quarterly installments as follows:

Beginning on the 14th day of April, 1954, and on the 14th day of each July, October,  
January and April of each year thereafter the sum of \$ 106.16 to be applied on the  
interest and principal of said note, said payments to continue up to and including the 14th day of October  
1957, and the balance of said principal and interest to be due and payable on the 14th day of January  
1958 the aforesaid quarterly payments of \$ 106.16 each are to be applied first to  
interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum on the principal sum of \$ 1,500.00 or  
so much thereof as shall, from time to time, remain unpaid and the balance of each quarterly pay-  
ment shall be applied on account of principal.

All installments of principal and all interest are payable in lawful money of the United States of America; and in the  
event default is made in the payment of any installment or installments, or any part hereof, as therein provided, the same shall  
bear simple interest from the date of such default until paid at the rate of seven (7%) per centum per annum.

And if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, or if default be made in respect to any con-  
dition, agreement or covenant contained herein, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due,  
at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity  
should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity, it should be deemed by the holder  
thereof necessary for the protection of its interests to place, and the holder should place, the said note or this mortgage in the hands  
of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses in-  
cluding (10%) per cent, of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be se-  
cured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, and in School District 6-E, being known  
and designated as the Northwestern portion of Lot 39 of a subdivision of  
the property of the estate of J. Rowley Yown, as shown on plat thereof re-  
corded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book J,  
pages 258 and 259, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southeast corner of the intersection of  
the Easley Bridge Road and Julien Avenue and running thence along the  
Southeast side of Easley Bridge Road, N. 60-00 E. 90 feet to an iron pin
