All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in Fairview Township County and State aforesaid and being more particularly described to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of a county road being joint corner of the property of the grantor and C. A. Parson, and running N. 83-10 E for a distance of 376 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running S. 2-49 W for a distance of 118 feet to an iron pin; thence turning and running S. 83-10 W for a distance of 376 feet to an iron pin being on the edge of said county road; thence continuing in the same direction to the center of said road for a distance of 26.5 feet; thence turning and running N. 2-49 E for a distance of 118 feet along the center of said road; thence turning and running N. 83-10 E. for a distance of 26.5 feet to an iron pin being the point of beginning. Said property being bound on the north by property of C. A. Parson, on the east and south by property of the grantor and on the west by said county road.
