All that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the east side of Vanderbilt Circle, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as Lot No. 33 on plat of White Oaks Subdivision, made by John D. Pellett, Jr., August 1946, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "P", at Pages 120 and 121, said lot fronting 95 feet along the east side of Vanderbilt Circle, and running back to a depth of 258.5 feet on the south side, to a depth of 238.5 feet on the north side and being 51 feet across the rear.

The above described property is the same conveyed to the mortgagor herein by deed of Benjamin Foster Wofford of even date and to be recorded herewith.
