

FIRST MORTGAGE ON REAL ESTATE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, Frank Goodwin,

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto LAURENS FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, LAURENS, S. C. (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee), as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of -----THREE THOUSAND FIFTY-EIGHT AND 70/100-----

DOLLARS (\$ 3058.70), with interest thereon from date at the rate of --SIX-- (6 %) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Fairview Township, containing 3.91 acres, more or less, according to a plat prepared by Lewis C. Godsey, Surveyor, March 18, 1954, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at an old iron pin on line of land of Dill Goldsmith and corner with Gault lands and running thence with the Gault land line N. 64-34 W. 641.6 feet to an iron pin in Western edge of a dirt road; thence with said road as a line S. 16-30 E. 585.2 feet to an iron pin, at intersection of said dirt road with a County dirt road, in Northern edge of said County road, thence on same course 20 feet to the center of said County road; thence with the center of said road N. 60-30 E. 100 feet to a point; thence N. 89-38 E. 196.7 feet to a point in center of said road; thence N. 26-30 E. 20 feet to an iron pin in the Northern edge of said road; thence on same course N. 26-30 E., 276.6 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning, and bounded by lands of Dill Goldsmith, Gault lands, other lands of the Grantors and others."

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
