All that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate at the Northeast corner of the intersection of South Plaza and West Plaza, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, in a subdivision known as "Lewis Plaza" as shown on plat made by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, dated June 1952, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "BB", at pages 54 and 55, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the Southern edge of a 5-foot sidewalk at the Northeast corner of the intersection of South Plaza and West Plaza, and running thence along the Eastern edge of said 5-foot sidewalk, N. 23-45 E. 37.5 feet to a point at the Northern edge of an 8-inch concrete block wall; thence along the Northern edge of said 8-inch concrete block wall S. 63-55 E. 33 feet to a point at corner of said concrete block wall: thence turning and running along the Eastern edge of another 8-inch wall, S. 26-30 W. 37.3 feet to a point on the North side of South Plaza; thence along the North side of South Plaza N. 64-13 W. 31.2 feet to the beginning corner.

It is understood that the mortgage of The Penn Mutual Life Insurance Company referred to above shall remain and continue as a lien on all property described therein, except as to
