Dollars, in and by our certain promissory note in writing of even date herewith, due and payable

\$35.00 on the 15th day of each and every month hereafter, commencing June 15th, 1954; payments to be applied first, to interest, balance to principal, with the privilege to anticipate after one year; balance due at the end of five years,

with interest from date at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum until paid; interest to be computed and paid monthly and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid, and We have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fee, if said note be collected by attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being thereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That We, the said Newton Roland and Iloan Roland in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said C. E. Robinson, as Trustee under B. M. McGee will, his Successors and Assigns, forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land on the East side of Fourth Avenue, in Section No. 2 of Judson Mills Village in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 27, as shown on a Plat of Section No. 2 of Judson Mills Village, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, in November, 1939, which Plat is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book K, at page 25, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the Southeast corner of the intersection of Fourth Avenue and Fifth Street, and running thence with the South side of Fifth Street, S. 83-53 E. 122 feet to an iron pin on said Street; thence with the rear line of Lot 6, S. 6-07 W. 80 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 26, N. 83-53 W. 122 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Fourth Avenue; thence with the East side of Fourth Avenue, N. 6-07 E. 80 feet to the beginning corner.
