"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Chick Springs Township, near Chick Springs, lying on the east side of the road that leads from the Old Chick Springs Road to and through the Southern Bleachery and Print Works Village, and being a part of the same tract of land that was conveyed to G. D. Collier by deed from C. S. Hammett, Executor, of the last Will and Testament of W. A. Hammett, deceased, said deed recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 284 at page 380, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

"BEGINNING on a nail and stopper in the east edge of the said road, joint corner of the Chandler lot, and runs thence with the Chandler line, N.81-00 E. 13.4 feet to an iron pin on the east bank of the said road, thence continuing with the same course for a total distance of 200 feet to an iron pin on the said line (this line projected 18.4 feet to the Chandler iron pin corner); thence from the 200 foot iron pin, N. 21-53 W. 150 feet to an iron pin, new corner; thence S. 81-00 W. 200 feet to a nail and stopper in the said road (iron pin back on line at 14 feet); thence with the said road, S. 21-53 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner, containing 0.67 acres, more or less, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
