

Lot No. 2 in Block G has a frontage of 70 feet on the West side of Cagle Street and a depth along Vine Street of 150 feet to an alley in the rear. Lot No. 3 in Block G has a frontage of 70 feet on the East side of Meadow Street and a depth of 150 feet to an alley in the rear.
