We, Raymond L. Hicks and Bobbie Lee O. Hicks, of Greenville County,

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Three Thousand, Nine Hundred and No/100 - - - - -

W. Poe Mfg. Co., Greenville, S. C.", made by Dalton & Neves, July, 1950, and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book Y, at pages 26-31, inclusive. According to said plat, the within described lot is also known as No. 34 Second Avenue, and fronts thereon 75 feet.
