"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, on the south side of East Faris Road (formerly known as Blassingame Street), being known and designated as Lot No. 4 of the property of James F. and Lena C. Yeager according to a plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book F, at page 141, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of East Faris Road, joint front corner of Lots 3 and 4, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 26-30 E. 193.8 feet to an iron pin in line with property now or formerly owned by J. A. Davenport estate; thence with Davenport line, S. 63-37 W. 60 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 4 and 5; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 26-30 W. 193.6 feet to an iron pin on the south side of East Faris Road; thence with East Faris Road, N. 63-20 E. 60 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
