C. in Plat Book "Y", at pages 26-31 inclusive, said lot fronting 70.3 feet along the northeast side of Seventh Avenue, running back to a depth of 75 feet along the southeast side to a depth of 75 feet on the northwest side and being 75 feet across the rear; being the same conveyed to us by Roy J.
