J. Martin as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book H, at page 139, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of Clarendon Avenue at the corner of Lot No. 1, which point is 80 feet east of the southeast corner of the intersection of an alley with said Clarendon Avenue, and running thence along the southeast side of said Clarendon Avenue, N. 46-10 E. 80 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 3; thence along the line of that lot, S. 35-22 E. 230.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 58-00 W. 64.7 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 1; thence along the line of that lot, N. 39-36 W. 215.0 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
