

BEGINNING at D. W. Smoaks corner on the north side of the White Horse Road; thence northeasterly with D. W. Smoaks' line 550 feet to a pin on D. W. Smoaks' line; thence parallel with White Horse Road southerly 250 feet to a pin; thence parallel with D. W. Smoaks' line southwesterly 550 feet to north side of White Horse Road; thence with north side of White Horse Road and northerly 250 feet to the beginning.
