aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and
also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me in hand well and truly paid at and before
the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted,
bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. B. Hall, his heirs and assigns forever,

all that tract or lot of land in
Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,
being known and designated as all of Lot No. 50 and the Southern one-
half of Lot No. 49 containing 25 feet as shown on plat of Elizabeth
Heights made by C.M. Furman, Jr., Engr. April 1928 and recorded in
Plat Book "F", at page 298, RMC Office for Greenville County and
described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Green ~~xxxx~~ Street, at the front corner of Lot
50 and running thence South 76-15 East 150 feet to an iron pin in line
of Lot 53; running thence North 13-30 East 75 feet to an iron pin,
said pin being 25 feet from the rear joint corner of Lots 49 and 50;
running thence through Lot 49, North 76-15 West 150 feet to Green
Street; running thence along Green Street, South 13-30 West 75 feet to
the beginning corner.
