All those two tracts of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, School District 12-F, about 12 miles north of Greenville Court House and 2 miles west of Locust Hill, on the branch waters of Mush Creek, containing ten acres in the aggregate, and being the same property conveyed to Claud Mote by H. N. Shaffer on July 9, 1948 by deed recorded in Book 352 at page 424, and described as follows:

One tract containing $6\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less, beginning at a stone, corner of L. J. Johnson land and thence running N. 77 3/4 W. 7,19 to a stone, corner of J. A. Center property; thence with the Center line S. 23 W. 2.37 to a stone at the fork of branch; thence S. 68 E. 17.70 to a stone; thence N. 15 E. 5.23 to the beginning corner, adjoining lands of Robert Williams, Harris Pittman and others.
