Greenville County, State of South Carolina. and in the City of Greenville, at the Southwest corner of Birnie and Howard Streets and being known and designated on the City Block Ecck as Lot Number 4 of Block 1 on page 76; said lot of land being described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:
