WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Six Thousand, Five Hundred and No/100 - - - -

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Greenville Township, on the Southwest side of Lynn Street in a subdivision known as Grove Park, being known and designated as Lot No. 2 of the property of Louie E. Smith, according to a plat thereof prepared by W. J. Riddle Surveyor, May, 1949, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Lynn Street, said pin being 184.8 feet Southerly from the intersection of said street with Mills Avenue, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 1, S. 45-27 W. 110 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 44-33 E. 5.2 feet to an iron pin; Thence S. 45-27 W. 237 feet to an iron pin on Brushy Creck; thence following the meanders of said creek in a Scutheasterly direction, 70 feet, more or less, to an iron pin; thence N. 45-27 E. 318 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of Lynn Street; thence along the Southwest side of Lynn Street, N. 44-33 W. 65.2 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises or to be installed thereon which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty; being the same lot of land conveyed to me by Louie E. Smith by deed dated June 1, 1949, recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Deed Volumn 383, page 365.

"The above described lot comprises the Southern portion of Lot No. 4 and the Northern portion of Lot No. 5 of Grove Fark, according to a plat recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in First Hook U, at page 173."
