SEND GREETING

Whereas, I, the said Charles M. Dogan - - - - -

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these Presents, am well and truly indebted to W.A. Hopkins

in the full and just sum of Nine hundred fifty - - - - - (\$50.00) - - - dollars, to be paid on demand

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid semi-annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, School District 1-1, containing twenty-three and fifteen one-hundredths, (23.15) acres, according to a survey made Feby. 4th, 1946, by W.E. Kasin, Regis. Surv. of S.C., having the following metes and bounds to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin, joint corner of John H. McKittrick and Blythe; thence N. 10-40 E. 13.87 chains to an iron pin on the north bank of branch; thence N. 10-40 E. 20.87 chains to an iron pin on road; thence due West. 19.90 chains to an iron pin, joint corner of Charles King and John H.
