TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

That the Mortgagee may require the maker, co-maker or endorser of any indebtedness secaled ed hereby to carry life insurance upon himself in a sum sufficient to pay all sums secured to inits mortgage, designating the Mortgagee as beneficiary thereof, and, upon failure of the Mortgager to pay the premiums therefor, the Mortgagee may, at its option, pay said premiums, and all sums so advanced by the Mortgagee shall become a part of mortgage debt.
