Henson and his heirs and assigns:

All of that parcel or tract of land in Glassy Mountain Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, lying on the South side of the Tugaloo Road, said road leading from Gowansville to Highland, and being all1 land lying East of a conditional line; and being the first tract of land described in a deed to Eva J. Dill from J.J. Hutchinson August 2, 1932, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 144, at page 165, and having the following description as shown in said deed: BEGINNING at O. Barton's corner(now or formerly O.
