NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor(s), in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor(s) paid by the said Mortgagee at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Mortgagee, Taylors

Lumber Company, Inc., its successors and assigns forever:

All of those parcels or lots of land in the City of Greer, in Chick Springs Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, located on the South side of Fleming Drive, being all of Lots Nos. 31,32,33 and 34 on a plat of property entitled "Relocation of Fleming Drive", made by Robert Jordan, Surveyor, to be hereafter recorded, having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on a stake on the South side of Fleming Drive, joint corner of lots Nos. 34 and 35 on said plat, and runs thence with the common line of said lots S. 12 W. 160 feet to a stake; thence N. 78 W. 326.7 feet to a stake, joint rear corner of lots Nos. 30 and 31; thence with the common line of these lots N. 18.27 E. 99.6 feet to a stake on the South side of Fleming Drive, inside of sidewalk; thence with the southern margin of said sidewalk and street curving northeasterly (the chord of which is S. 85.43 E.) 71.7 feet; thence continuing with the margin of said street and sidewalk, curving in a northeasterly direction (the chord of which is N. 72.17 E.)108.3 feet to a stake, joint front corner of lots Nos. 32 and 33; thence continuing with the margin of said street and sidewalk S. 78 E. 150 feet to the beginning corner.

The above lots are the same as conveyed to the mortgagor herein by Mae F. Duncan, et al, as Executors of Earl Dixon Duncan, by deed not yet recorded, and deed from J.E. Fleming to be hereafter recorded.
