"All those "All the certain pieces parcels or lots of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 21 and 34 on Plat of North Garden recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book EE at Page 63, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds to-wit:

## LOT NO. 34:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of North Garden Circle at the joint front corners of Lots 34 and 54, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 54 S. 80-48 W. 195 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of Pleasantburg Drive; thence along Eastern side of Pleasantburg Drive N. 9-12 W. 75 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 34 and 35; thence with line of Lot No. 35 N. 80-48 E. 195 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of North Garden Circle; thence with said street S. 9-12 E. 75 feet to the beginning corner."

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of North Garden Circle at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 21 and running thence S. 9-12 E. 192.7 feet to an iron pin; thence with the right-of-way of Duke Power Company S. 80-40 W. 75 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 21 and 41; thence with line of Lot No. 41 N. 9-12 W. 192.2 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of North Garden Circle; thence with North Garden Circle N. 80-48 E. 75 feet to the beginning corner."
