PARCEL NO. 1. All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying and being on the Northwesterly side of Oakland Street, at the intersection of Webster Alley, in the City of Greenville, S. C., being shown as the property of Ward Stone according to a plat thereof made by Piedmont Engineering Service, dated October 3, 1950, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book Z, page 41, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
