in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof, according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to us in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Peoples National Bank of Greenville, South Carolina, as Guardian for Gale Diane Galyean, its successors and assigns,

all that tract or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 1, 2 and 3 of Camilla Park according to Plat of Camilla Park made by Dalton & Neves, December, 1927, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "G", at Page 225 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest corner of the Easley Bridge Road and Washington Road and running thence with Easley Bridge Road, S. 61-57 W. 180 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 35; thence with line of Lot No. 35, S. 26-37 E. 188.8 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 4; thence with line of Lot No. 4, N. 65-30 E. 163 2/10 feet to an iron pin on the West side of Washington Road; thence with the West side of Washington Road N. 21-55 W. 200.1 feet to the beginning corner.
