NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Butler Township, on the southwest side of Gladys Drive, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 38, 39, 40 and 41 of a subdivision of the property of J. B. Hall and R. E. Cox known as Glad Acres as shown on plat thereof made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, on April 15, 1946 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book S, at page 13, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southwest side of Gladys Drive, the joint front corner of Lots 37 and 38, and running thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 58-51 W. 248.5 feet to an iron pin on the line of property of Mrs. J. W. Tench; thence along the line of that property, S. 29-30 E. 200.4 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 41 and 42; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 58-51 E. 254.3 feet to an iron pin on the southwest side of Gladys Drive; thence along the southwest side of Gladys Drive, N. 31-09 W. 200 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
