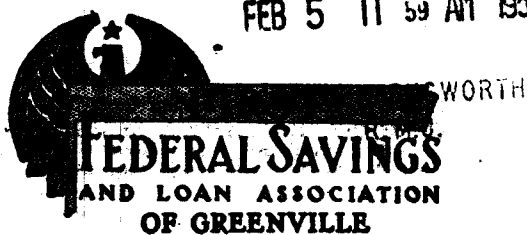

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

COUNTY OF GREENVILLE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, Jack E. Strickland, of Greenville, S. C.,

SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

VILLE, in the full and just sum of Three Thousand, Nine Hundred and No/100

(\$ 3,900.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate specified in said note, to be repaid in installments of

Thirty-Nine and No/100 (\$ 39.00)

Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee beside all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in Greenville Township, School District #160, and being known and designated as Lot No. 8, of the property of Jack E. Strickland as shown on plat thereof, as made by J. C. Hill, Surveyor, on August 6th, 1954, and being a portion of Lot No. 49 of the property of J. Rowley Yown as shown on plat recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book J, at page 258, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southeast side of a 30-foot street known as Strickland Drive at the corner of Lot No. 9, which point is 449.7 feet from the southeast corner of the intersection of Welcome Road, and running thence along the line of Lot No. 9, S. 73-00 E. 171 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of said lot in line of the property of Hammond; thence along the line of that lot, S. 17-00 W. 70 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 7; thence along the line of that lot, N. 73-00 W. 171 feet to an iron pin at the corner of said lot on the southeast side of Strickland Drive; thence along the southeast side of said drive, N. 17-00 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner".

The above described lot is a portion of the property conveyed to me by Ever Jane Wilkie by deed dated August 17, 1954 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 508 at page 217.

Included in this mortgage will be all the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures which are hereby declared to be a part of the realty.

Since this is a construction mortgage a lapse of a period of more than 30 days without any construction work being done thereon, or a failure to complete the house within a reasonable time shall constitute a breach of the terms of this mortgage and the holder hereof may institute foreclosure proceedings without delay.
