bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said
Margaret M. Thompson, her heirs and assigns forever:

all that tract or lot of land in
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements
thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being
in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the East side of
Parker Road, and being front portion of Lots Nos. 48 and 49, as shown on
plat of Junction Heights, recorded in Plat Book C, at page 106, and also
shown on plat of property of Ola Westmoreland made by J. C. Hill,
December 7, 1949, and from the latter plat has the following metes and
bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Power Street, at
corner of Lots Nos. 47 and 48, and running thence with the
dividing line of these lots, S. 37-00 E. 147.67 feet to corner;
