SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said H. A. Lollis
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these
Presents, am well and truly indebted to Citizens Bank of Fountain Inn, S. C.
in the full and just sum of Three Hundred Sixty - - - - - Dollars
to be paid as follows: \$30.00 on March 1, 1955 and \$30.00
on the first day of each month thereafter until paid in full

with interest thereon from date
at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly
