in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Gantt Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 164 of a subdivision known as Chestnut Hills as shown on a plat thereof being recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book GG, at page 65, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Butternut Drive, joint front corner of Lots 163 and 164, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 7-55 W. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 82-05 E. 70 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 164 and 165; thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 7-55 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Butternut Drive; thence with said drive, N. 82-05 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
