Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, Greenville in the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds according to a plat thereof made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, Dec. 1929 BEGINNING at an iron pin joint corner of lots 63 and 62 and running thence, N. 80-02 E. 54.5 feet along Overbrook Road to an iron pin; thence continuing with Overbrook Road N. 84-02 E. 50 feet to an iron pin in joint line of lots 62 and 61; thence with the line of lots 62 and 61, S. 13-13 W. 202.5 feet to an iron pin on a 10 foot alley; thence N. 76-47 W. with the line of said alley, 88 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 9-13 E. 173 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of lots 63 and 62 the point of beginning.
