(\$\frac{12,000.00}{})\$ Dollars, or for future advances which may be made hereunder, from time to time, up to and including the maximum amount named herein, such advances to be repaid so as to be completed within the terms of the original contract, and so long as the monthly payments set out in the note are paid according to contract, this loan shall not be deemed delinquent by reason of said advances, with interest at the rate specified in said note,

(the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference) to be repaid in installments of

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I/we, the said mortgagor(s) in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me/us the said mortgagor(s) in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, the following described preparty to-wit: following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southern side of Windsor Drive, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 22 and 24, according to plat of Northwoods Subdivision, plat made by Piedmont Engineering Service, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "W" at page 21, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the southern side of Windsor Drive in the center of a branch, which iron pin is the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 22, according to said plat, and running thence along the center line of said branch in a curved line, the chord of which is S. 7-28 E. 180.4 feet to a point in the center of said branch, the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 22; thence N. 89-31 W. 171.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 2-29 E. 178.6 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Windsor Drive; thence along the southern side of Windsor Drive, S. 89-32 E. 14 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the southern side of Windsor Drive in a curved line, the chord of which is S. 75-58 E. 67.6 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the southern side of Windsor Drive in a curved line, the chord of which is N. 66-17 E. 44.3 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with the southern side of Windsor Drive, S. 89-32 E. 20.5 feet to an iron pin in the center of said branch, the point of beginning. "

The last payment on this mortgage, if not sooner paid, will become due and payable 20 years after date.
