all that tract or lot of land in

Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land in the County of Greenville, State Of south Carolina in Butler Township, lying and being on the East side of S. C. Highway No. 291 and and being known and designated as Lot No. 8 as shown on plat of property of J. H. Sitton according to Survey made by Piedmont Engineering Service on April 13, 1955 and recorded in Plat Book II, at page 127, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and having the following metes and bounds to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of S. C. Highway No. 291 at the joint front corner of Lots 7 and 8 and running thence along the joint line of said lots, South 88-15 East 189.87 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 7 and 8; said point being on the edge of a 30-foot service alley; running thence along said service alley, South 0-43 West 50.02 feet to an iron pin; running thence along the joint line of Lots 8 and 9, North 88-15 West 191.35 feet to an iron pin on the Eastern side of S.
