(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FOUNTAIN INN FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF Fountain Inn, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by

reference, in the sum of One Thousand Five Hundred and no/100

DOLLARS (\$ 1,500.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of six per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be paid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, and

WHEREAS, the unpaid balance of said debt or debts, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does hereby grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Fairview Township and in the Town of Fountain Inn, with the following metes and bounds, according to a plat made by E. E. Gary, Surveyor, July 12, 1947:

Beginning at an iron pin in the western edge of Shaw or Thackston Street, joint front corner with other land of the Grantor, and running thence with said street, S 41-45 E, 68 feet to an iron pin, joint front corner with lot of Claude Fowler; thence with line of said Claude Fowler, S 42-20 W, 144 feet to an iron pin on line of Chamblee lot; thence with line of said lot N 49-40 W, 75 feet to an iron pin, joint back corner with other land of the Grantor; thence with line of land of the grantor N 45 E, 153 feet to an iron pin on Shaw or Thackston Street, the point of beginning, and bounded by property of Claude Fowler, property of Bill Fryor, property of A. E. Green and property of Bayne and being the same property as conveyed to the mortgagor by deed from Henry C. Curry dated July 21, 1947 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 315 at page 398.
