WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, GREENVILLE, S. C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference in the sum of

DOLLARS (\$ 7,500.00), with interest thereon from date at the rate of 5-1/2%
per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid as therein stated, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Grant Township, near Welcome Church, and having according to Plat made by J. Mac Richardson, dated April 1, 1952, the following notes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a Spanish Oak on the East side of the Staunton Bridge Road, corner Bethlehem Church lot; thence S. 67-33 W. 1209.16 to a Hickory on Charles line; thence along Charles line, S. 24 E. 99.4 feet to white oak; thence along White's line, N. 75 W. 1027.1 feet to an iron pin on line of property of J. R. Fullbright; thence along his line, S. 66-37 W. 146.7 feet to an iron pin; thence in the center of the Staunton Bridge Road; thence along the center line of said road, S. 61-47 W. 281.1 feet to an iron pin; thence along the center line of said road, S. 61-47 W. 168 feet to an iron pin; thence along the center line of said road, S. 24-11 W. 207.9 feet to the center line of said road, including 12.7 acres, more or less.

The above described property is the same conveyed to the Mortgagor by J. R. Fullbright by deed recorded in the R. C. Office of Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 42, at page 11.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

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
