WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto Guy W. Strickland

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of

Twelve Hundred Twenty-Five and 50/100 - - -

DOLLARS (\$ 1225.50

with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per centum per annum, said principal and interest to be repaid: in monthly installments of \$17.41 each on the 5th day of each month hereafter to be applied first to interest, balance to principal, until paid in full with interest thereon from date at the rate of Six (6%) per cent, per annum, to be computed and paid monthly until paid in full.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe pursuant to the covenants herein and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (\$3.00) Dollars to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, his beirs, successors and assigns:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the western side of Wilburn Avenue near the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot #78, on a plat of Westview Heights recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book M at Page 11, and having the following metes and bounds according to a plat prepared by J. C. Hill in May, 1955, as follows:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the western side of Wilburn Avenue 465 feet north from Hill Street at corner of Lot 77, and running thence with line of said lot S. 85-56 W. 125.6 feet to a stake; thence N. 9-42 E. 50.25 feet to a stake at corner of Lot 79; thence with the line of said lot N. 85-56 E. 130.6 feet to a stake on Wilburn Avenue; thence with the western side of Wilburn Avenue S. 4-04 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner."

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
