WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto GENERAL MORTGAGE CO.

organized and existing under the laws of THE STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA, a corporation
called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which
are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Eight Thousand and Six Hundred - -
Dollars (\$ 8,600.00), with interest from date at the rate of four and one-half per centum
(4-1/2 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of
General Mortgage Co. in Greenville, South Carolina,
or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of
Forty Seven and 82/100 - - - - - Dollars (\$ 47.82),
commencing on the first day of August, 1955, and on the first day of each month there-
after until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest,
if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of July, 19 80.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better
securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three
Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained,
sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its
successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville,
State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the City and County of Greenville,
State of South Carolina, being designated as Lot 9, Block 1 on a Plat of Section A
of Parkvale on Summit Drive according to said plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office
for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book "K" at Page 52, and having the
following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the West side of Summit Drive (formerly Bennet Street) and
running thence N. 89-0 W., 167.6 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 12-0 W., 70.0 feet
to an iron pin; thence S. 88-45 E., 172.4 feet to a point on the West side of said
Summit Drive; thence along the West side of Summit Drive, N. 8-20 E., 69.9 feet to
the point of BEGINNING.
