SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I, the said James H. Sutton

hereinafter called the mortgagor(s)

in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to B. S. Hodges

DOLLARS (\$ 6800.00), to be paid

\$100.00 on July 1, 1955 and a like amount on the first day of each and every month thereafter up to and including May 1, 1960 and the balance of principal on June 1, 1960, said installments to be applied first in payment of interest and balance to principal

, with interest thereon from date

at the rate of six (6%) percentum per annum, to be computed and paid

monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor(s) promise to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

S. Hodges,

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 5 and 7, on plat recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in plat book F page 249, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin at the northeast corner of Parker Road, and New Cut (Bramlett) Road, and running thence with the northern side of said new cut (Bramlett) Road, N. 63 E. 150 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 5; thence with the line of said lot N. 36-36 W. 100 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 8; thence with the line of said lot S. 63 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on the northeast side of Parker Road; thence along the northeast side of Parker Road S. 36-36 E. 100 feet to the beginning corner.
