with interest thereon from date

6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid. the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof. who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage: and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. B. Hall, his

heirs and assigns forever, covering all that piece, parcel or tract of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina on kthe East side of Cedar Lane Road near the City of Greenville, containing 4.9 acres, more or less, being known and designated as lot no. 15 of Farr Estate as shown on plat of said property made by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, July 1941 and according to said kplat on property described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the East side of Cedar Lane Road at the corner of the Black property formerly the Griffin property running thence along Black line N 61-48 E. 701 feet to a stake; thence N. 57-30 W. 243 feet to a stake on branch; thence down the middle of said branch as a line 50 feet to a point; thence S. 35-30 W. 172 feet to a stake; thence S. 54-30 W. 580 feet to a stake on Cedar Lame Road; thence along said road 3.35-45 E. 114 feet to bend;
