All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 3-A as shown on a plat entitled "Revised Plat of Lots Nos. 1, 2 and 3, Maple Acres" prepared by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, March 30, 1954, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book HH at page 43 (said plat being a revision of Lots 1, 2 and 3 as shown on a plat of Maple Acres recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book FF at page 111) and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Chastain Drive, the joint corners of Lots Nos. 2-A and 3-A, and running thence along the Western side of Chastain Drive N. 14-30 E. 82.5 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot 3-B; thence along the line of that lot N. 75-30 W. 150.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 27-57 W. 84.58 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 1-A; thence along the rear lines of Lots 1-A and 2-A, S. 75-30 E. 170.2 feet to an iron pin, the beginning corner.
