WHEREAS, I/we the aforesaid mortgagor(s) in and by my/our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am/are well and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS & LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREEN-

(\$ 6,500.00 ) Dollars, or for future advances which may be made hereunder, from time to time, up to and including the maximum amount named herein, such advances to be repaid so as to be completed within the terms of the original contract, and so long as the monthly payments set out in the note are paid according to contract, this loan shall not be deemed delinquent by reason of said advances, with interest at the rate specified in said note,

M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book P at page 127, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, towit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Brookside Circle at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 121 and 122, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 37-34 E. 148.5 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of said lots; thence along the rear line of Lot No. 93, S. 52-26 W. 75 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 93 and 94; thence with the joint line of Lots 120 and 121, N. 37-34 W. 158.2 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Brookside Circle; thence with Brookside Circle, N. 60-06 E. 75.7 feet to the beginning corner; being one of the lots conveyed to me by William S. H. Piper by his attorney-in-fact, Ruth M. Piper, and Ruth M. Piper by deed dated March 31, 1955 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 523, at page 408."
